- Doctoral Degree in Sociology, Human Development and Family Science, Gerontology, Demography, or related field.
- Substantive research interest and a publication record in the research area(s) of marital dynamics, health and well-being, sexual minority populations, and/or health disparities.
- Demonstrated expertise with quantitative data and longitudinal and/or dyadic data analysis.
- Effective time management, attention to detail, and problem-solving capabilities.
- Able to work both independently and collaborate with a team as needed.

The postdoctoral fellowship is initially for one year beginning August 2022, with the option to renew for an additional year(s) contingent on performance. The salary for this position will be \$50,000+, depending on qualifications and experience.
