Bower School of Population Health. The Department of Population Health Science engages in population health research, program implementation, and population health management consultation, and offers three graduate degree programs and one certificate program.

The ideal candidate will have a doctoral degree and specific training in population health or a closely related field (e.g., public health, social and behavioral health); a prominent record of academic scholarship; a demonstrated capacity to secure external research funding; dedication to faculty and staff career development; and a history of advocacy for community-engaged, collaborative, and translational research. The candidate will also have significant experience with academic, administrative, and fiscal leadership. The candidate will exhibit a vision for population health science and management in addressing health care disparities, social determinants of health, health care policy, and health care economics.

The chair of the Department of Population Health Science reports to the dean of the School of Population Health and oversees the budgetary, administrative, and personnel issues of the department, helping to grow collaborations and partnerships both on and off campus.
